

Get Outside and Build Your Pals Their Own Paddock!



Let's Play Tricks With Sticks!



Start by gathering up all kinds of branches, all about the same width.

Get **a pruning shears**, **a ruler**, and **a grownup to help**.

With your grownup, measure and cut six Y-sticks, with the bottom tips cut to points.

Next, find five straight sticks, and cut them to 11" long, plus one endearingly fanciful stick for the gate. If you can't find a fanciful stick, a straight stick will make a wonderful gate too!!



Put your Pal or Pals in the middle of where you want your Paddock to be. Now it's time to shape it up. We made a paddock in a **6-sided hexagon*** shape!

With your ruler as a guide, push two Y sticks into the ground, **10" apart**, with the Y-parts pointing up.

Continue to place Y-sticks 10" apart until you form a hexagon shape.

> *This shape is a hexagon; it has six sides.



You'll need a grownup to help with this activity!

Now, **connect two Y-sticks with a straight stick**. Continue connecting Y-sticks with the remaining sticks until you form a hexagon paddock.
